Experienced Agility Classes

The experienced agility classes run on a weekly basis and continue upon what you have learnt during the first two courses. These classes are designed for dogs which can successfully complete 12 weaves and contacts. Handlers are required to have a good understanding of handling manoeuvres to get the most of these classes. The class is currently held on Sunday evenings 8:00pm- 9:30pm but as this classes fills another class with be started on a Friday evening 8:00pm - 9:30pm.

What you will learn

These classes alternate between drills (focusing on specific handling manoeuvres) and courses of differing experience levels. This class is designed to continue with and enhance your training as well and giving you more experience of walking courses and finding the best route for both yourself and your dog.

The primary focus of these session is still on having fun with your dog, but also continuing to gain experience with agility in a friendly and relaxed atmosphere.

What you need to bring

- Suitable footwear and clothing as you will be running
- High value treats NB homemade gluten free treats can be pre-ordered and purchased on the night £1.50 per 200g
- A favourite toy NB S.I.T has a number of training toys available for sale.
- Poo bags please clean up after your dog and remove all faeces from the site when leaving.
- A lead for when not taking part in an activity – PLEASE KEEP ALL DOGS ON A LEAD UNLESS DIRECTED OTHERWISE
- While training is held in an indoor riding school there is no heating so warm clothes and a coat for your dog maybe required.
- PLEASE DO NOT FEED YOUR DOG 4 HOURS PRIOR TO CLASS!

Each class is charged at: £5.00 per dog non-club members £4.50 per dog club members.
